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Assessment of Contributions of Group Members

The peer evaluation scores will be averaged for each student and are weighted according to the percentage you decided at the beginning of the course for your group and incorporated into the final grade for the TBL.

Evaluate the contributions of each person in your group <u>except yourself</u>, by grading them on a scale where maximum is 100% (A = 90-100, B = 80-89, C = 70 to 79, D = 60-69, F = below 60). If you give a grade less than 100%, you **must** include comments for that person below his or her name: your comments will be shared anonymously with the student you are evaluating.
